Feb 2010, to augment irrigation of the farm's veggie plots, water tank is built.



But before it is used for source of drip irrigation, taking a dip is well in order.



Municipal water proves too expensive, so deep well pump is being installed, see right photo. Note tank's green drip hose line. Now tank is a superfluous reservoir for irrigation, and is seeded with tilapia fingerlings in June. On left photo, upon return from US in Sept, tank is ready for first harvest.
